Rush County's Readiness for Change Part 2: Community Insights Recap



In part 1 of this series we shared the final report from Ball State about Rush County's readiness for change along with a summary of background data about the challenges our community is facing.

Last fall we held a series of eight Community Insights Meetings throughout the county to learn what YOU think about your community and our county.

We asked participants to answer five questions:

- 1) What **one word/image** comes to mind?
- 2) What would be agame changer?
- 3) What do you **like** about your community?
- 4) What do you **love** about your community?
- 5) What would you like to love about your community?

In most sessions, participants were also asked to pretend they had been away from their community for 25 years and to write a postcard to someone describing what they saw (or didn't). Check out a summary of their answers and read some of the "postcards from the future" in part 2 of this series.
