If you're 70½ or older with an IRA, you can make a big difference for your community – and your taxes – with a QCD. **When you ask your financial advisor to make a gift directly to RCCF, it is not counted as taxable income.** Plus, if you are 72 or older, it can satisfy your RMD (Required Minimum Distribution).

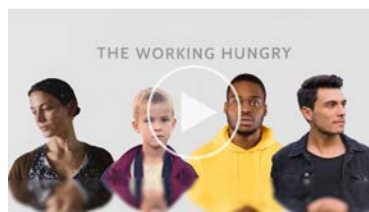
