We encourage you to use the prompts as a way to ignite conversation with your child.


Have fun!

Kids who have heard more words tend to start school with larger vocabularies, become stronger readers, and score higher on tests.


It's not only about talking to your child, but talking with your child.



Go on a scavenger hunt and see if you can find:


- O a smooth hock
