

Supplies: Marshmallows Toothpicks

Use the toothpicks and marshmallows to create a snowflake.

Snowflake designs are all unique To make a symmetrical snowflake, you can create one side and have the little create the other side to match. Or let them be creative and make a snowflake however they desire!

Discussion Questions:

- How many marshmallows did we use?
- How many toothpicks were used?
- How many different snowflake shapes can we make?
- Can you draw your snowflake on a piece of paper?

Did you know... Pinching and arranging the marshmallows on the toothpicks is a great way for littles to work on fine motor skills.

Tip: Let the marshmallows sit out for a day and they won't be as squishy to use.
